According to the work, Amir Temur and Saraymulkhanim met for the first time in childhood in Zanjirsarai, and then Amir Temur asked her his name. The girl replies, Bibikhanim.

If we take into account the fact that Saraymulkhanim was born in 1341, this meeting is close to the truth, that is, it leaves no doubt in the reader's mind. Considering the distance between 1370 and 1405, there are 35 years. But there were no conditions for them to be close to each other, there was no conversation between them.

In the writer's novel "Sarbadorlar", when Amir Temur and Sultan Husayn argue, Saraymulkhanim listens to their discussion from behind the sarpar.
