The oldest writings related to critical thinking were written by Plato, and Socrates created his teachings. In ancient times, Socrates tries to emphasize that every case must be carefully studied and proved by evidence, and he sets up his own system of questioning. He also calls this questioning system "Socratic questioning" and develops a famous strategy of critical thinking. he studied and created a method of doubting reasonable arguments. Plato continues the works of Socrates and creates << Socratic teaching>>. Critical thinking teaches people to be more careful in how they think and make decisions. Also, critical thinking encourages a person to make logical conclusions, to get out of difficult situations easily, to think about things not from one side, but from many sides.
