The population of Uzbekistan on average consumes twice as much meat products, milk and dairy products, and eggs as compared to the population of the country as a whole, and the share of the population with an average gross income of less than 5 soums per month was slightly more than 12 percent in the country, but it reached 45 percent in our republic.

Social infrastructure networks: health care, public education, preschool institutions were in a very bad condition, 60% of schools and hospitals were located in poor buildings, and there were very acute economic and social problems. Considering that our republic is mainly a base of raw materials, a source of raw materials for industrial ministries and agencies, local, socio-economic features of the country are sometimes not sufficiently evaluated, sometimes completely, and sometimes these features are not even appreciated.
