Therefore, the student should quickly write down the given task will be needed. The second student will have to write down the positive and negative meaning of the synonym. Such methods develop the student's quickness, beautiful written literacy and thinking ability. For example:

By writing "friend" on the border, a student will have to quickly write synonyms.

That is, it is necessary to write oshna, brother, comrade, brother, brother.
